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JUDGING: Monday @ 8 AM

In selecting vegetables and fruits for exhibition, choose specimens that would bring the highest market price.

Do not select the largest; select medium size specimens. Do not mix categories, if possible.

The following factors are generally used by an expert vegetable/fruit judge:

Specimens from the same variety

Uniformity in shape, size and color.

Be sure to pick out a perfect specimen, then select others as similar as possible-choose same maturity

Protect from dirt, disease, infection and mechanical damage- choose specimens with no blemishes

Check premium requirements carefully-enter the number or amount required to avoid disqualification

Not responsible for entries after 10 PM on Saturday Premiums only paid for varieties listed in premium book
