1. All ATVs must remain parked in the pit area unless competing in an event.
2. All riders must wear a helmet
3. All vehicles must have brakes
4. All participants must meet the qualifications of the class:
examples: "female" -both driver and rider-
"15 and over" - both rider and driver.
5. Participants who hit the incoming/outgoing gate with their ATV will be disqualified from that event.
6. Flag Race - all (3) flags must be in the buckets for time
7. Please look at all class qualifications before entering (especially the classes that are listed by bike size).
8. If you are not sure of the course pattern (ex: T-Barrels), check at the booth. Pattern maps are available.
